Please provide the following information in support of your request for modification:

1. Photograph of both the front and back of your home – including “line of sight” from golf course if your home backs up to the golf course.
2. Photograph of existing landscape, including the tree(s) or landscaping to be removed.
3. Name or type of tree/landscaping that will replace the landscaping/trees that you plan to eliminate or change. (A picture of similar plants/trees will be sufficient). (Note: stumps need to be ground out or removed)
4. Sample/photograph of materials to be used for retaining wall or other structure, i.e., timber, rock etc. Include color (should be neutral where required).
5. Photo of location on property for installation of retaining wall and other new materials.
6. Provide any design specifications/drawing/measurements for retaining walls and different materials.
7. Include the plat/plot plan with dimensions of where structure/materials will be located. (Be sure to reference from lot lines and house).

Projects begun without ARC approval are subject to fine.
